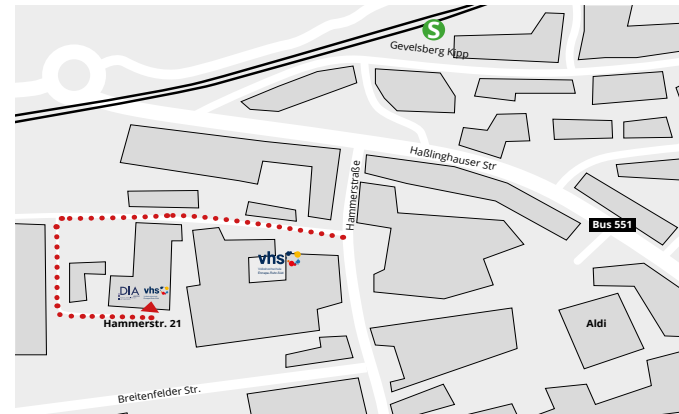
Start date: from January 6, 2025
